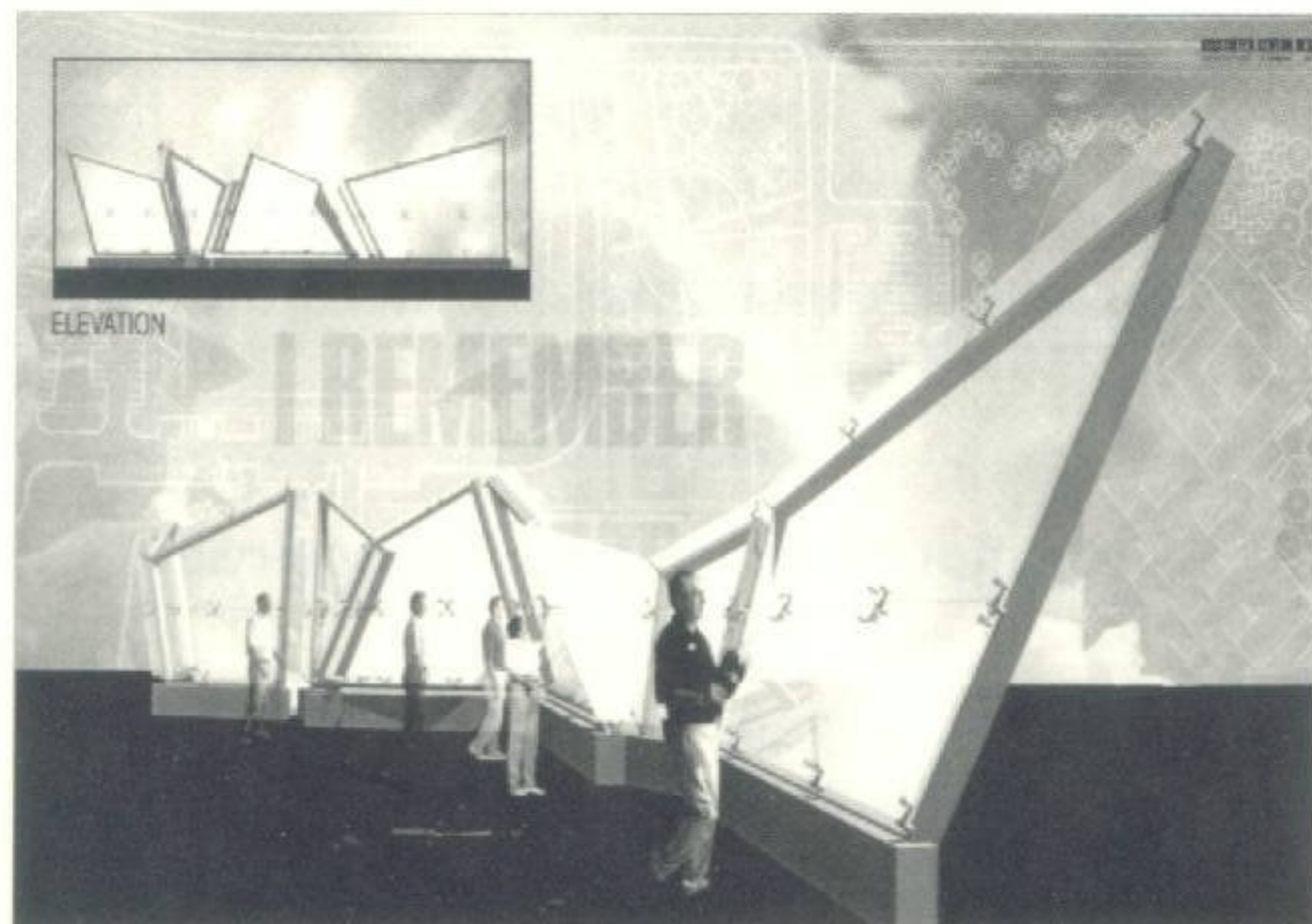


The Colorado Freedom Memorial gives us all - family, friend, neighbor, comrades - a place to pay respects to the memory of those who did not return.

The Memorial will be constructed of glass that will reflect Colorado's mountains and blue skies. Approximately 14 feet tall and 125 feet long, the glass panels will be etched with the names of the over 6,000 who have paid the ultimate price for our freedom. Privates, Generals, MIA's, all wars and branches of service honored in one place. There is no memorial in America like it.

The Colorado Freedom Memorial will be constructed on a two-acre parcel near Buckley Air Force Base in a new park being built by the City of Aurora. The city has contributed a generous lease for the land as their support for the project.

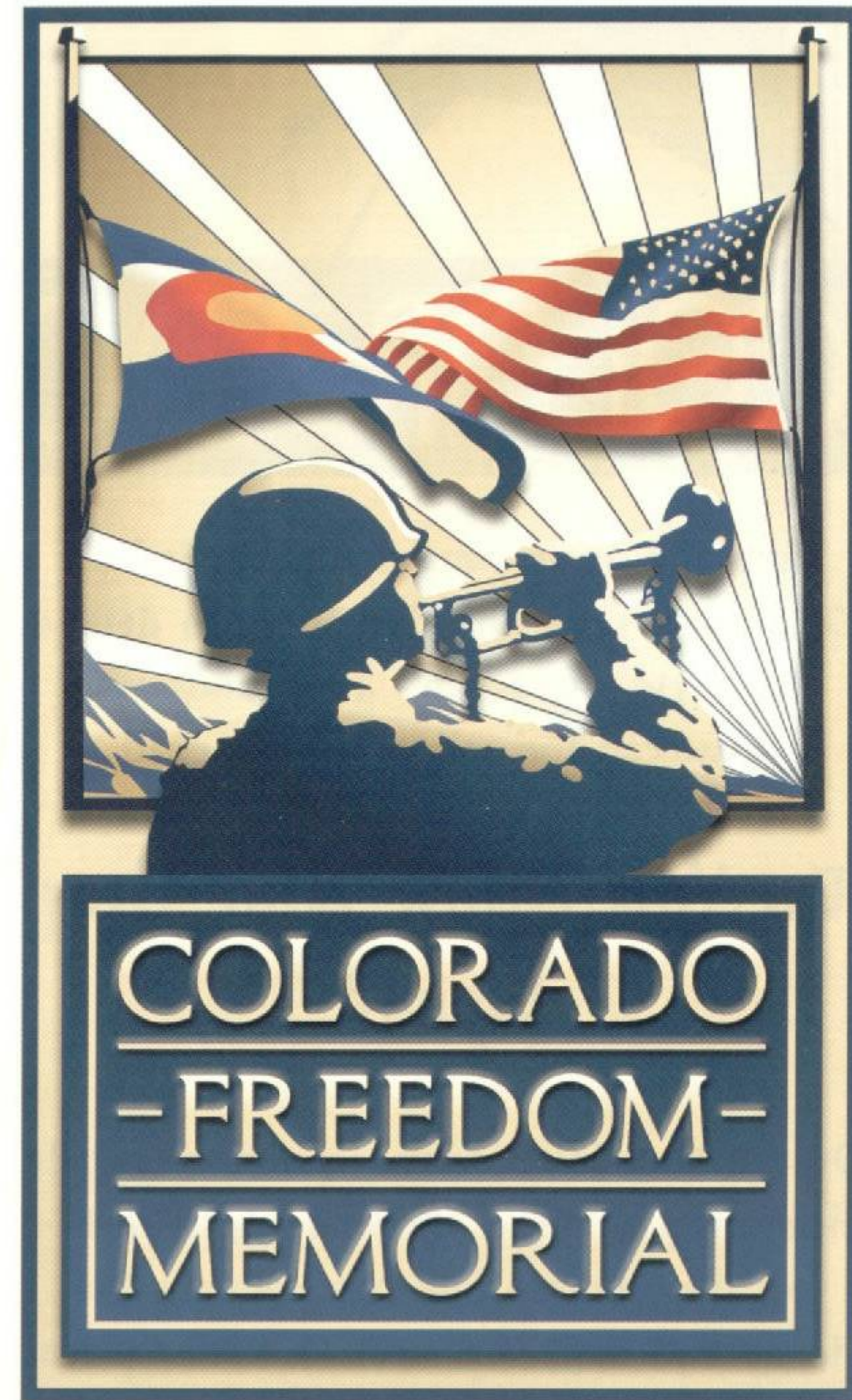
